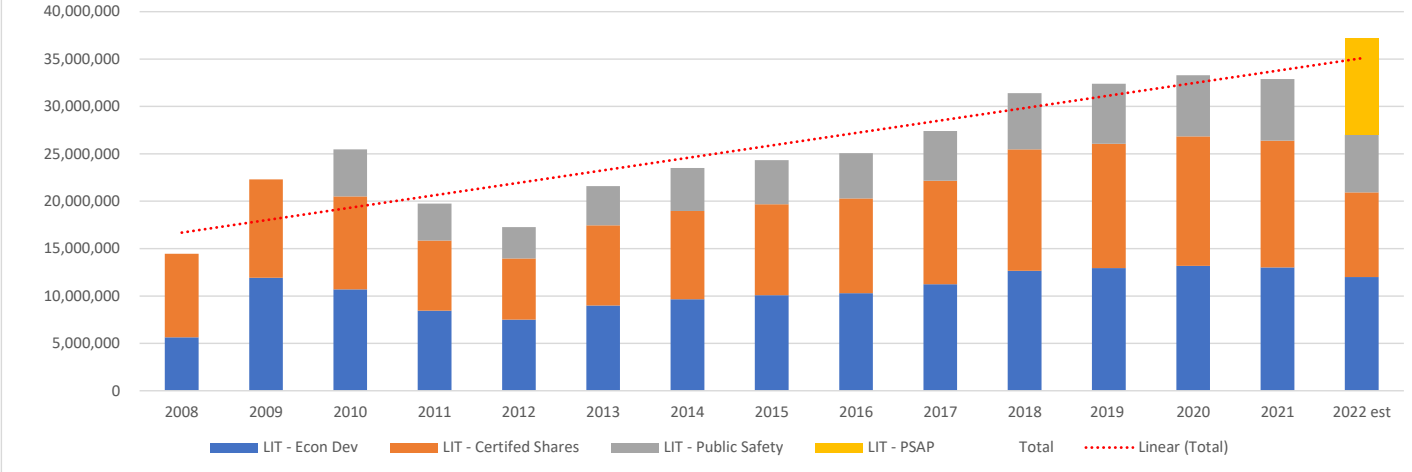

2019 revenue includes supplemental amounts of \$771,789 (LIT-Certified Shares), \$452,757 (LIT-Public Safety) and \$931,315 (LIT-Economic Development). Total - \$2,155,861.00

2020 revenue includes supplemental amounts of \$1,386,590 (LIT-Certified Shares), \$655,382 (LIT-Public Safety), and \$1,340,238 (LIT - Economic Development). Total - \$3,382,211.00.

2021 revenue includes supplemental amounts of \$429,159 (LIT-Certified Shares), \$203,926 (LIT-Public Safety), and \$415,543 (LIT - Economic Development). Total - \$1,048,628.
